




40-3015-04 - Universal Hipervision module

INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL


Depending on the training equipment model Bluetooth module maybe located in various locations. Below are 2 possible locations.

NOTE: Some configurations contain a screw that prevents the module from sliding out. Remove screws prior to module removal



POWER AND SIGNAL CONNECTIONS:

Power is provided by either 4 C-Type batteries or an external power supply from 4 to 6 vdc. Undo Velcro straps to replace batteries. After new batteries are installed ensure that the straps are installed properly and tightened sufficiently to prevent batteries from falling out.





Sample installation shown below. Spring loaded clamping bracket can automatically adjust to various devices and securely hold them in place while in use.




40-6043 - Smart device clamping bracket





STEP 1 (INSTALLATION)


1-1 Locate HIPERVISION battery port cover and when applicable plastic end cover.




- 1-2 Remove both covers and put them aside.

1-4 Slide module inside the tube as shown and install 4 screws as indicated








- 2-1 Connect power plug into the module

QUICK TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

In case of connection issues please perform the following steps first

- 1. Ensure that all cables, power and signal, are connected properly and are fully seated.
- 2. Check batteries It is recommended to check and replace batteries every 3 to 5 months. Check proper contact in the battery holder and clean any contacts that may have gotten oxidized.
- 3. Use a multimeter continuity function to check sensor cables
- 4. Check cables and make sure there is good contact between cable connectors and Hipervision board sockets
- 5. Ensure that bluetooth function is enabled on the smart device. Delete all connected bluetooth modules using Bluetooth Settings and restart connection process. Follow link below for a detailed video instruciton.
